Sainmhíniú

Tá Oideachas Caidrimh agus Gnéasachta (O.C.G.) mar chuid den chlár forleathan a bhaineann le riachtanaisí an pháiste. Cuirtear síos i gcuraclam agus i dtreoirínte an CNCM ar an ábhar agus modheolaíocht atá le húsáid i mhúineadh na gclár O.C.G. Beidh an clár ar fail sa scoil. Leanfaidh an scoil na treoracha seo. Moltar go láidir go mbeadh gach páiste rannpháirteach ann. B'fhéidir go mbeadh gá le cainteoir neamhspleách chun ábhar ar leith a mhúineadh.

Soláthar á dhéanamh do thacaíocht, forbairt & athbreithniú leanúnach

Tá súil ag an scoil go gcuirfeadh áiseanna scoile ábhartha ar fail chun cuidiú le tuismitheoirí agus múinteoirí. Déanfaidh an scoil iarracht deimhin a dhéanamh de go mbíonn deiseanna forbartha ionghairme ag múinteoirí agus an coiste polasaí, agus tacaíocht a thabhairt do thuismitheoirí chun deiseanna oideachais a sholáthar do thuismitheoirí eile.

Chorcaí i Mí Feabhra 1998 (9ú-19ú) agus cuireadh an leabhrán "Oideachas Caidrimh & Gnéasachta—Ag dul ar aghaidh le chéile" chucu chomh maith.

D'fhreastail an coiste ar chúrsa oiliúna san Ostán Doughcloyne (23/09/98) agus 'san Ostán Westpark (17/11/98). Tháinig said le chéile arís ar 19ú Mí na Samhna 1998 nuair a cuireadh an chéad dréacht le chéile.

Cuireadh an dréacht polasaí chuig na húdaráis scoile chun gur féidir le múinteoirí agus thuismitheoirí glacadh leis agus é a chraobhscaoileadh.

Our School Philosophy

1. The school will seek to communicate the Christian vision of human life and human relationships.
2. The school will recognise that, in the area of R.S.E. above all, its role is subsidiary to that of parents.
3. It will reflect the school's spirit of respect and tolerance of all families and children in an inclusive and Christian manner.
4. The dignity, privacy and modesty of each individual child and family will always be respected.

Definition

R.S.E. is part of a cross-curricular programme which addresses the needs of the whole child. It specifically addresses growth, development, relationships, the meaning of human sexuality, and relevant personal and social skills. (Central to R.S.E. is the fostering of self-esteem).

Relationship of R.S.E. to S.P.H.E.

What is Social, Personal and Health Education (SPHE)?

Social, Personal & Health Education (SPHE) contributes to developing the work of the school in promoting the health and well-being of children and young people. The content of a school's SPHE programme will include a wide range of topics such as healthy eating, alcohol, drugs, environmental issues, safety and social responsibility, as well as R.S.E.

What the school currently provides

The school provides for S.P.H.E formally as follows;

The Alive O Religion Programme,

The Stay Safe Programme,

The R.S.E. Programme,

The North Western Health Board Primary Health Education Programme (Infants—R.6),

Walk Tall,

These programmes are available for those who wish to read them.

Aims of our R.S.E. Programme

At primary level, R.S.E. aims to help children learn, at home and in school, about their own development and about their friendships and relationships with others.

This work will be based on a respect for the humanity and spirituality of the child and will focus on;

- (a) Developing a good self-image,
- (b) Promoting respect for themselves and others,
- (c) Fostering a healthy attitude to human sexuality,
- (d) Providing the children with age-appropriate information,

At all times, this policy will reflect the value and ethos of the school.

The Management & Organisation of R.S.E. in this School

The school will deliver the curriculum as outlined in the NCCA R.S.E. document. This is available for those who wish to read them. Participation by all children is strongly recommended. The school may invite speakers from outside agencies to teach certain aspects of the curriculum.

Provision for ongoing support, development and review

It is hoped that resources such as videos and books will be provided to support parents and teachers with this programme. The school will aim to ensure access to in-career development opportunities for other parents.

How the R.S.E. policy was drafted

The draft was drawn up by the R.S.E. School Policy Committee (two members of the Board of Management, two parents and two teachers). Parents were informed by newsletter (3/02/98) of public meetings which were held in Co.Cork (February 9th—19th 1998) and were circularized with a booklet entitled "Relationships and Sexuality".

The Committee attended a Training Session on 23/09/98, Doughcloyne Hotel and 17/11/98 in the Westpark Hotel. It met again on 19/11/98 when the policy was drafted.

The drawn up policy was sent to the Board of Management for approval and dissemination among staff and parents.

Consulting Staff and Parents

A copy of the draft policy was sent to parents, giving them the opportunity to respond in writing. A general meeting of all the teachers was arranged to discuss their views on the draft policy. All comments, opinions and suggestions received were examined by the committee and amendments to the draft policy were deemed unnecessary. The policy was sent to the Board of Management for approval.

Circulation of R.S.E. Policy

The approved school Relationships and Sexuality Education Policy statement, is circulated among parents and teachers.
